
Action on Disability offer Mentor training. Job Coach Support will also be provided.

We are Action on Disability and in a partnership with local councils and West London College, we run Supported Internships for Disabled Young People and those with additional needs to find paid employment.

The Supported Internships is a one year programme for Disabled Young People aged 16-24 years-old with an EHCP who are ready to progress from education into the workplace.

During the work placement, you will have Job Coach support, offering training and awareness. Engagement with the programme with enable you to become a Disability friendly organisation.
